1. JOHN¹ NUTTER was born 1791 in Briercliffe, Great Marsden, and died Bet. 1861 - 1864 in Burnley, Lancashire. He married SARAH SPENCER 07 Feb 1813 in Burnley, Lancashire¹. She was born 1790 in Little Marsden, and died Bet. 1851 - 1859 in Burnley, Lancashire.

Notes for JOHN NUTTER:

1841 John & Sarah both aged 50 + 3 sons James (24), Quick (23), Samuel (22) & 3 daughters, Susan (15), Marey (17), Sarah (7). Living in Holt Hill, Briercliffe with Extwistle. John is married to Ann. No Alice (if indeed she was John & Sally's) married or died?.

1851 John (60) & Sarah (60) living in Nelson Houses, Little Marsden. All weavers. James (24), Quick (22) are at home + Samuel (21) & Ann (daughter-in-law 21- Samuel's wife) & granddaughter Sarah (4 mths.) Mary is married to Bannister Leaver.

1851 - 61 Wife Sarah died.

1861 Widower John, 70, 'old and infirmed', is living with son Samuel, Powerloom Cotton Weaver (31) & his wife Ann (32) in Cop Row, Briercliffe. 2 sons James (8), Robert (3 mths.) & 2 daughters Mary Ann (2) & Sarah (10).

1871 Samuel & Ann aged 40 living in Grove Terrace, Great Marsden with Sarah (20), James (18), Robert (10), Willie (5), Thomas (3), & John (1). No Mary Ann!

1881 Samuel, cotton weaver aged 57 & Ann (57), living in Victoria Street, Nelson. James, Robert, William, Thomas, John & Ann at home.

1885 Ann died.

1891 Samuel (widower) living at 32, Holbeck Street, Burnley with John (21) & Ann (18). All cotton weavers.

1894 Samuel died.

2. JOHN² NUTTER (JOHN¹) was born 09 Apr 1816 in Pig Hole, Briercliffe, Great Marsden, and died 02 Jan 1896 in 9, Netherfield Road, Nelson, Lancashire². He married (1) ANN HALSTEAD³ 03 Sep 1838 in St. Peter's Parish Church, Burnley⁴, daughter of JOHN HALSTEAD and SARAH WATSON. She was born 15 Oct 1820 in Hag Gate, Briercliffe, Great Marsden, and died 24 Jun 1852 in Little Marsden, Lancashire⁵. He married (2) NANCY INGHAM Bet. Oct - Dec 1854 in Registered in Burnley. She was born Abt. 1810 in Briercliffe, Great Marsden, and died Bet. Jan - Mar 1892 in Nelson, Lancashire.

John NUTTER Born 9 April 1816 John Sally Pighole in Briercliffe Haggate Baptist Chapel (Briercliffesociety.co.uk)

I wonder if this is the correct John - why didn't he marry at Chapel?

1838 John married Ann Halstead at St. Peter's Church (Burnley Parish Church). Religion - C. of E. Henry Halstead (Ann's brother) and John Spencer were witnesses. (Marriage certificate).

1841 Weaver aged 25, married to Ann 20, 2 children Robert (2) & Ellen (5 mths.) Living at Holt Hill, Briercliffe with Extwistle. Ann's sisters Phoebe (22) & Sarah (18) live next door (also James 1).

In 1851 the census was taken on 30th March. James was 3 months old then, so he must have been born in January 1851. He was the only child to have been born in Little Marsden, so the family must have moved between 1848 (John's birth July - September) and January 1851.

1851 John is a beamer* aged 34, married to Ann 30. The family live at Pye Grove, Little Marsden (St. Paul's area). Robert (11) & Ellen (10) + 3 more children Susannah (8) Should this be Sarah Ann? In 1861 census Sussannah is 13 (b. 1848?) but 1 of them is missing from 1851 census. John (2) & James (3 mths).

*A beamer was employed to wind the warp on the roller (beam) before putting it on the loom. Parkfield Mill at the top of Railway Street was the nearest mill.

1852 Ann died 24th June from consumption. She was 31 and there was no doctor present. Sarah Nutter made her mark on the certificate as she was present at Ann's death. Daughter Sarah was 9 at the time. (Death certificate).

John married Nancy Ingham between October & December 1854. Their son Benjamin was born in 1857.

1861 John is a cotton warp beamer, 44, living at Belle Vue, (St. Johns), Great Marsden with Nancy, 7 children and 3 step-children (Halstead, John & Martin). Stepdaughter Ellen (21) & Mary Foulds (1) are lodging. Ellen (nee Ingham) had married John Foulds in 1859. He died in 1860 so Ellen came to live with her mother and stepfather. Ellen Nutter had married in 1859.

1871 Living in Claremont Terrace, Nelson. Susanah 23, James 20 & Benjamin 14, are at home, as well as Ellen (nee Ingham) & Mary Foulds (11). All the Ingham children have left home, as well as Robert (married), Sarah Ann (married), Mary (married) and John (married).

1881 Aged 65 & a cotton warp beamer. Living in Netherfield Road, Nelson. Benjamin 24, Mary & Ellen still there. Susannah (staying with Sarah Ann & husband, Richard) & James (married) weren't there.

1888 Benjamin married Elizabeth Jolley.

1889 Elizabeth died aged 26.

1891 Living at 9, Netherfield Road, Nelson. Nancy is called Mary (81 right age). John is 74, living on own means. Benjamin is a widower (34), Frederick Nutter is 1 and Ellen Foulds (John's stepdaughter) is 57.

1896 John, retired cotton twister, died from old age, aged 79, on 2nd January in Nelson. Benjamin was present at his death at 9, Netherfield Road, Nelson.

Widow of John Ingham weaver born 1816.

1841 Married to John & living at Pig Hole Mill, near William (17) & Betty Nutter (12).

1881 Living at 2, Robinson Street, Burnley. Walker is wheelwright - no children. Martha Maria Windle (21) is a general servant from Burnley. Martha is William Windle's granddaughter (Ellen's cousin John's daughter).

1891 Aged 50 & living at Croft Top, Higham with Walker, a farmer - no children.

1900 Ellen died on 15th October.

1901 Walker is a widower aged 63. He is living in Wheatley Lane, Barrowford and working as a blacksmith & wheelwright.

1904 Walker died aged 67.

1891 Single, weaver aged 44 & living with sister Mary & husband Greenwood Pickles at 8, North Street, Nelson.

1901 WHERE WAS SUSANNAH? She is not in census as Nutter in any county acc.to Ancestry. She is not registered as deceased.

There are 5 possible marriages between 1891 & 1901.

Father, John Nutter, was living in Netherfield Road. The local church was St. John the Evangelist in

Barkerhouse Road, C. of E. The only marriage to take place there for a 'Susannah Nutter' was in 1891 to John Harrison. Susannah would have been 42. Can't trace her in 1901 as S. Harrison. Maybe she thought that she was too old for a church wedding?

1892 James William Kirshaw married a Susannah Nutter at St. John the Divine in Cliviger. No record of either in 1901.

There is 1 wedding at Burnley Registry Office to Moses Greenwood in 1893. This Susannah Nutter was born in Briercliffe but she is only 36 in 1901, whereas Susannah would have been 53. Moses is 43 and has 3 children from a previous marriage to Ann Emmott, who died in 1890. The 36 yr. old Susannah lived in Briercliffe in 1891 aged 26.

1 wedding to Major Heap in 1898 at St. Mary's in Nelson. This Susannah was born in 1879 in Nelson.

1 wedding to James Leach at Holy Trinity in Burnley in 1900. This Susannah was born in Burnley in 1877.

The only other Susannah that got married was Robert & Betty's daughter b. 1878 to John Crankshaw.

1871 Married Sarah Pollard between July & September.

1881 Married to Sarah from Colne. A cotton weaver living in Elm Street, Nelson (opposite side of road from St. Philip's Church. There was an Independent Methodist Chapel opposite on Leeds Road).

1891 Cotton weaver (40) living with Sarah (40) & niece, Alice Leaver (10), Sarah's sister, Mary Ellen's daughter) at 27, John Street, Nelson. (ran from Thomas Street to Commercial Road). Near to the railway station.

1901 Still at 27, John Street, Nelson. He & Alice are cotton weavers. Sarah is 50.

1851 Bannister (26), Mary Ann (27), both powerloom weavers, are living in Hibson, Little Marsden with their 3 children, Elizabeth (6), Bannister (3) & John (7 months).
Ancestry transcribes as 'Laver'.

1861 Bannister (36) is living in Nelson with wife 'Jane' (46 from Trawden) & children Elizabeth (16) , Bannister (13) both powerloom weavers & John (10).

1871 Bannister (47) & Jane (57) are both cotton weavers, living in Vine Street, Nelson. Sons Bannister (23) & John (20) are living at home. Elizabeth is married.

1881 Bannister is boarding with the Howarth family from Briercliffe at 8, Print Street, Habergham Eaves. He is a widowed cotton weaver aged 57.

1901 Bannister died before census.

1851 Married to Luke, handloom weaver, living in High Sim Briercliffe. They have 3 children. Ellen (6), Sarah (4) & John (1).

NB

In 1841 High Sim is listed as a place of 6 cottages in which 38 people lived. Only 1 occupation, that of handloom weaver, is recorded. Taken from 'A Lancashire Township' Roger Frost.

1861 Married to Luke, a stone quarrier from Briercliffe. Living at Club Houses, Little Marsden (next to Nelson Inn). Ellen, Sarah, Richard, Thomas & James at home. John died in 1858 aged 8.

NB

Luke's change of occupation is undoubtedly due to the demise of the handloom, overtaken by industrialisation and powerlooms.
The stone quarry could have been Catlow Quarry between Catlow Farm & The Sportsman Inn.

1871 Living in Ellen Street, Nelson. Luke is unemployed. Richard (18), Thomas (14) (both cotton weavers) & James (11) are at home. Ellen & Sarah have both married Hargreaves. Are they brothers?
Ellen Street ran between Carr Road & Market Street, behind the Lord Nelson Hotel.

1881 Luke (61 birthdate changed to 1820) & Susannah (56) on their own at 12, Gravel Lane, Nelson (St. Paul's area near the vicarage). Luke is a stone breaker/road labourer.

1885 Luke died between July & September aged 65.

1891 Susannah (66) living on her own means, alone at 12, Gravel Lane, Nelson.

1892 Susannah died aged 67.

1861 Powerloom Cotton Weaver aged 33, living in Cop Row, Briercliffe. 2 sons James (5) & William (7). (Brother Samuel & wife + John - father - living in Cop Row too). Mary Sutcliffe (Ann's mother) listed as boarder/servant aged 54.

Cop Row is listed as a street in the area of Lane Head. There were 40 cottages in 3 terraces making up the 'Cop Row'.

1871 Living in Barkerhouse Road, Nelson with Ann, William & James. Also Mary Sutcliffe listed as mother (in-law).

1881 Still in Barkerhouse Road. James & Mary Sutcliffe have gone. William is a widower with son John

aged 5 living with them.
1881 Quick died between April & June.

1841 Living with mother Mary Sutcliffe & Grandfather Robert Heys (65) in Hag Gate. Edmund Nutter & Ellen live next door.

1851 Handloom weaver aged 26. Living in Cop Row with Mary Sutcliffe (mother) and Ann Heys (16) Mary's niece.

1871 Cotton weaver aged 41. Still married to Ann and living in Grove Terrace, Nelson. Sarah (20) & James (18) are cotton weavers. Mary Ann is gone. Willie (5), Thomas(3) & John (1) are there.

1881 Living in Victoria Street, Nelson. Says that Ann was born in 1824. Ann (daughter) born in 1873.

Sarah gone. Sons still there.

1885 Wife Ann died between July & September.

1891 Cotton weaver aged 61 (widower). John (21) & Ann (18) both cotton weavers still at home.

1894 Samuel died between October & December.
